If you are unable to attend a session, you or a parent/guardian must call the Encore Theatre at 847-708-8880 at least one hour before class begins. **Three missed rehearsal times will result in forfeit of this scholarship and remaining tuition fees will be due prior to continuing the program.** Furthermore, the student participant will not be guaranteed their current role in the production should they miss three or more rehearsal times. Tech Week and Dress Rehearsals are mandatory.

2) You will be on time for all rehearsals.

3) You will bring appropriate materials/attire to all rehearsals.
